

Post-Operative Medication Instructions

Please follow these eye drop instructions for your upcoming surgery. If you currently use eye drops for other reasons, continue them as prescribed unless instructed otherwise by your surgeon.

- MOXIFLOXACIN (antibiotic)
 - Apply 1 drop to the surgical eye 4 times per day
 - Start after surgery and continue for 2 weeks
- <u>DICLOFENAC or KETOROLAC</u> (non-steroidal anti-inflammatory)
 - Apply 1 drop to the surgical eye 4 times daily
 - o Start after surgery and continue until gone
- PREDNISOLONE ACETATE (steroid anti-inflammatory)
 - o Apply 1 drop to the surgical eye 4 times per day
 - o Start after surgery and continue until gone
 - Shake well prior to each use

Space multiple doses of the same drop evenly throughout the day. Wait at least **5 minutes** between applications of different drops.

Eye drops should be ready for pickup at your pharmacy within 24 hours of your pre-operative nurse phone call from the AEC Surgery Center.
