

Imprimis Drop Instructions

Associated Eye Care offers combination eye drops through **Imprimis Pharmacy** as an alternative to traditional eye drops. This pharmacy can mix multiple eye drop medications into a <u>single</u> bottle through a process known as "compounding." Imprimis drops are preferred for most patients for the following reasons:

- **Simpler regimen.** Instead of 3 bottles each with different instructions, patients use a single eye drop that contains all 3 medications.
- Reduced cost. While not covered by insurance, most patients pay less out of pocket for Imprimis drops compared to equivalent drops from a traditional pharmacy. These drops are almost always less expensive than using your insurance unless you have no copay.

Please stop at the front desk in our LASIK suite to purchase your drops on the day of your surgery. The LASIK suite is located just inside the main entrance of our Stillwater office. The cost for the drops is \$62 per bottle. If you provide a form of payment ahead of time, this will be charged through the morning of your first surgery for each bottle needed. After purchasing your drops, you will be directed to the surgery center which is only a few steps away.

Eye Drop Instructions

- Imprimis Combo Drop (prednisolone acetate / moxifloxacin / bromfenac)
 - Apply 1 drop to the surgical eye 3 times per day
 - o Start after surgery and continue until gone
 - Shake well before each use
